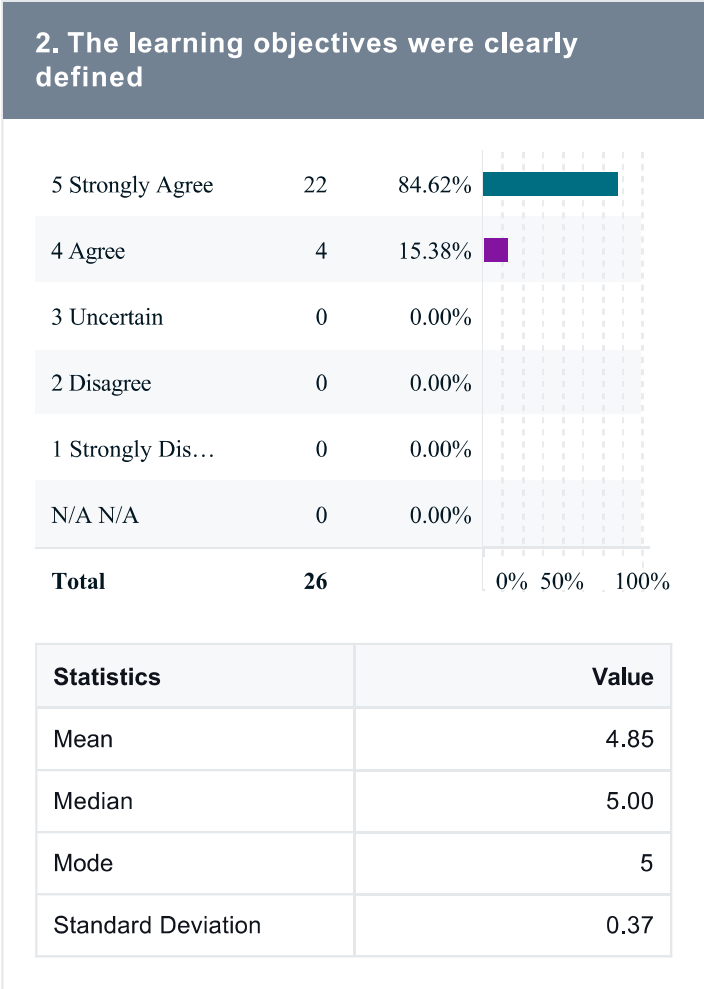
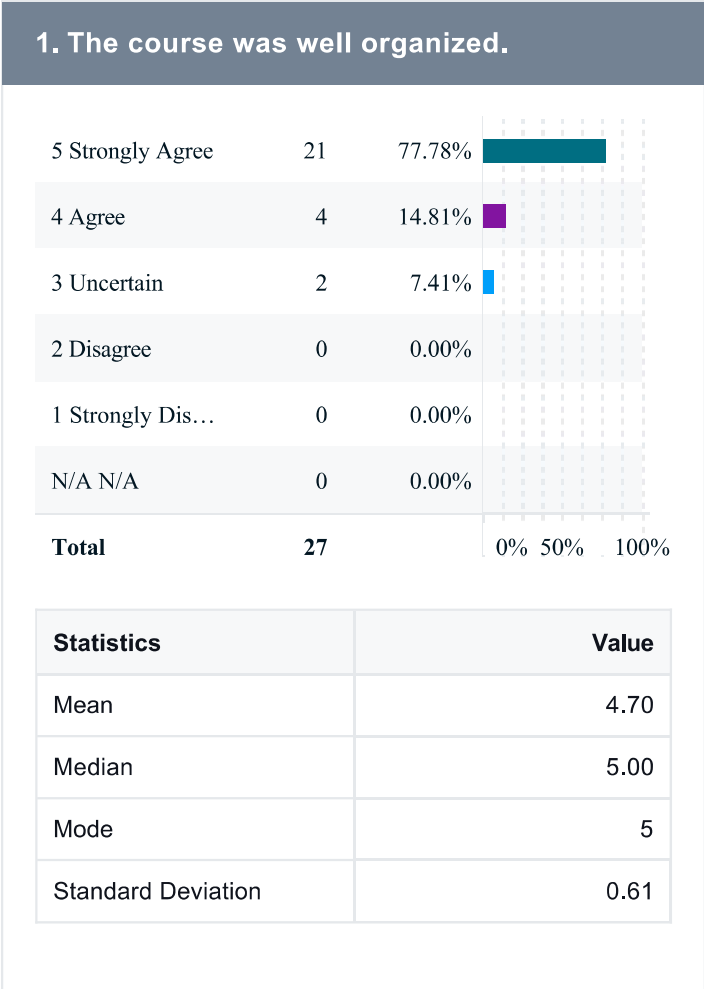

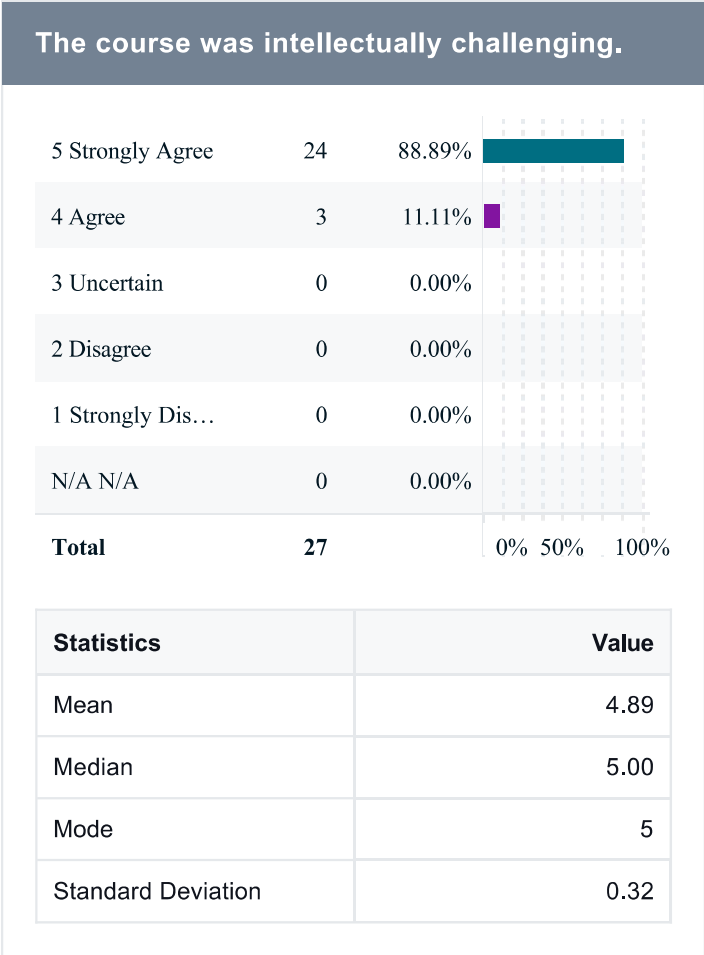
Distribution of Responses

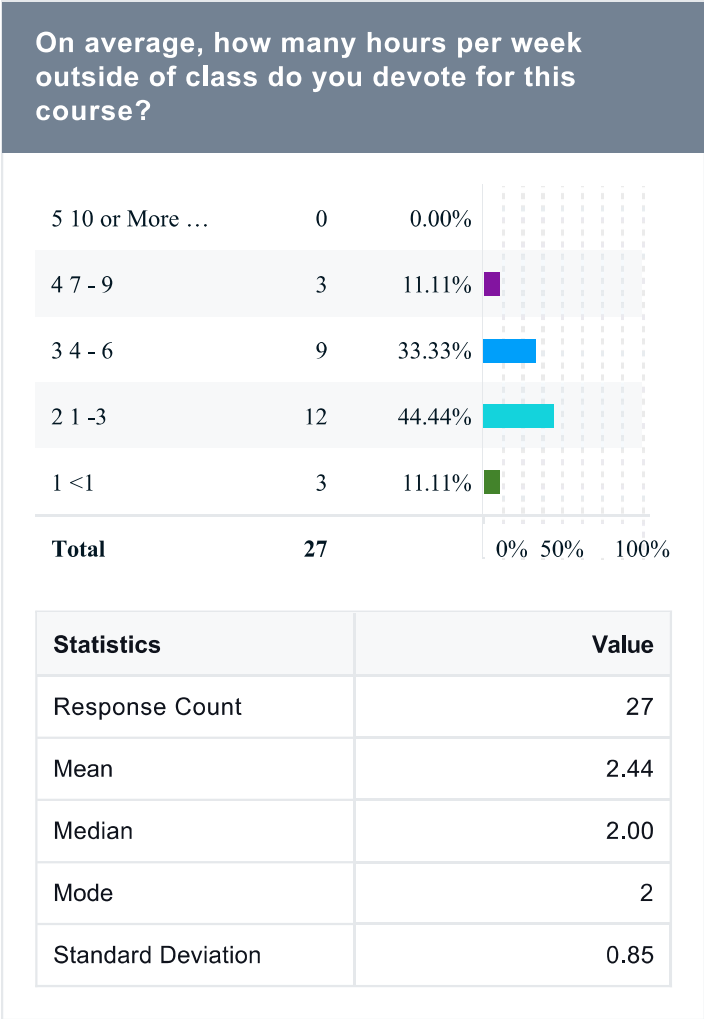

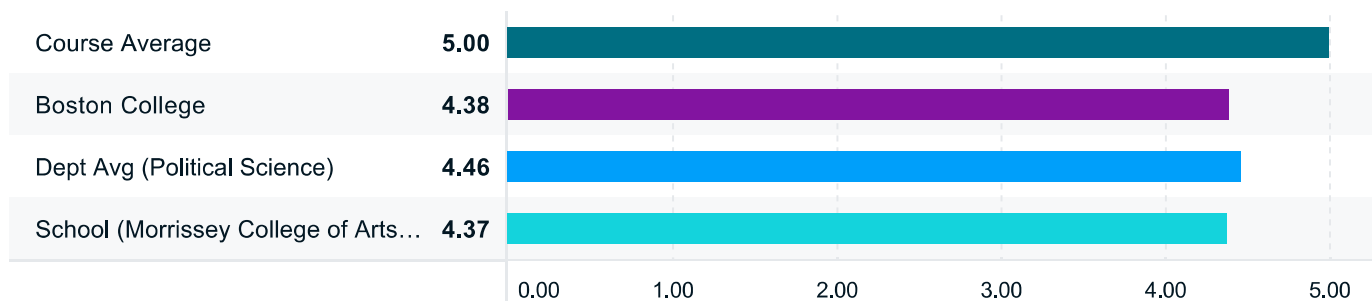


On average, how many hours per week outside of class do you devote for this course?

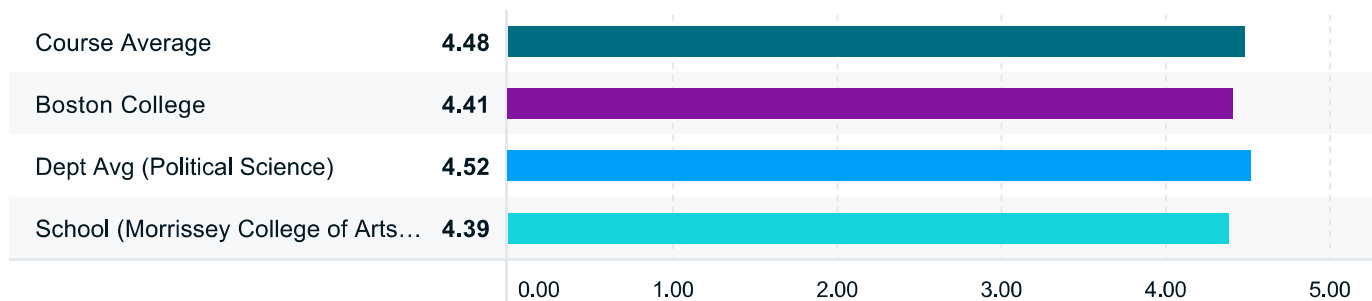
