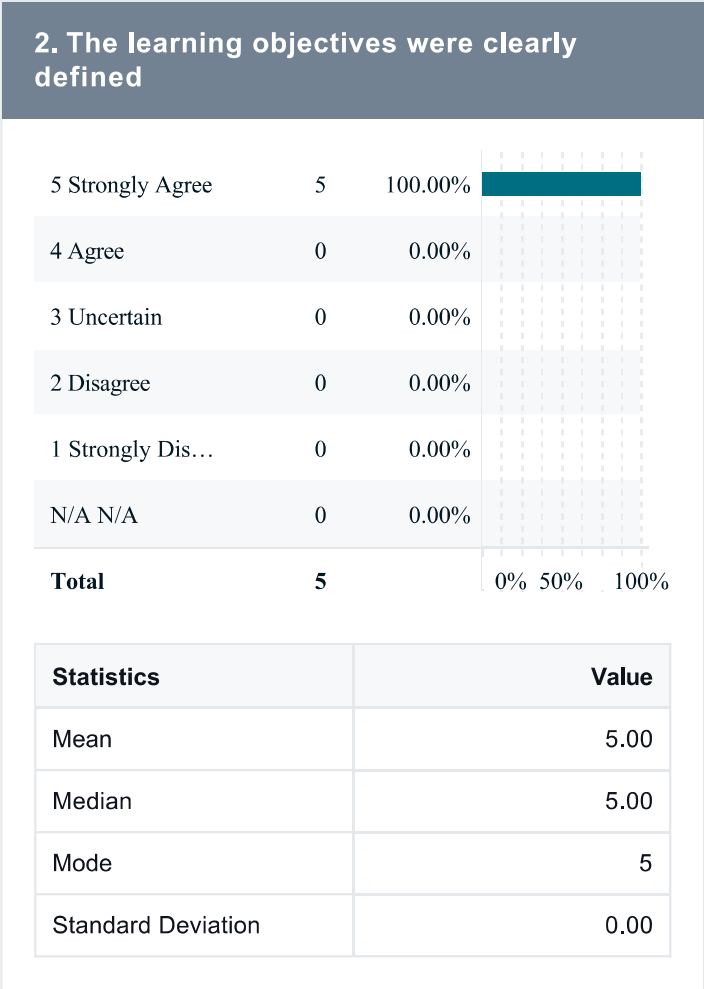
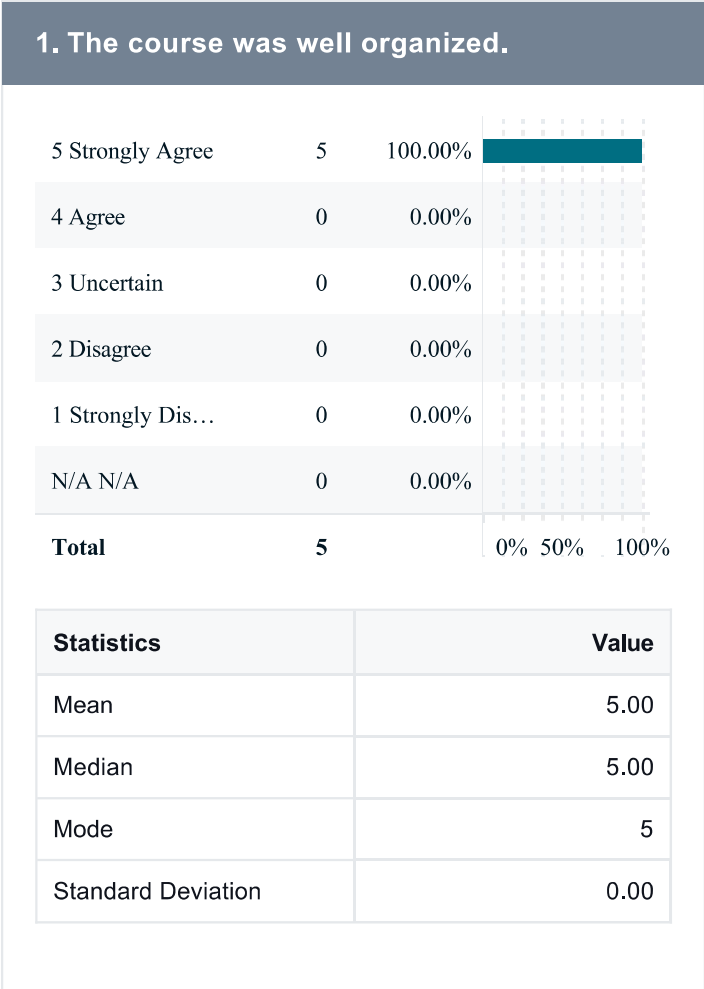

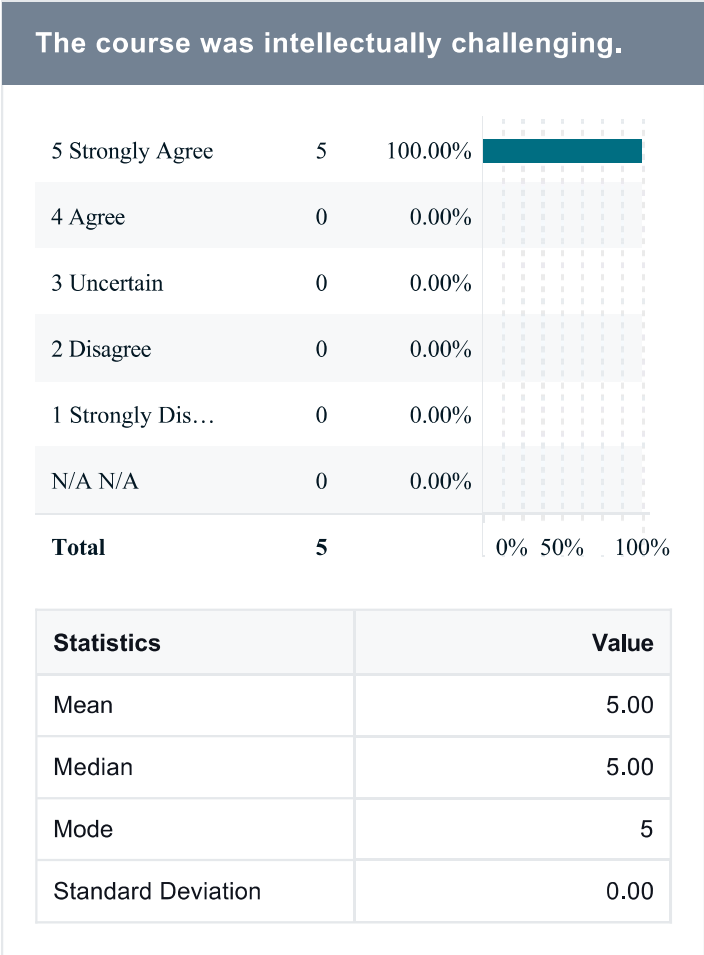
Distribution of Responses

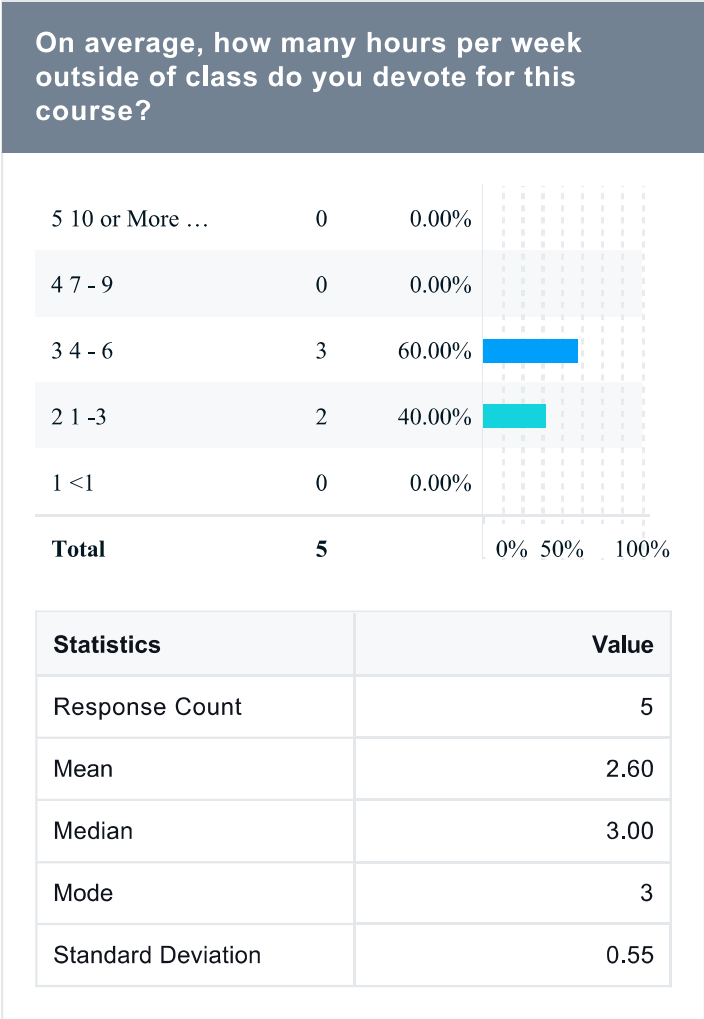

Readings that weren't just academic papers

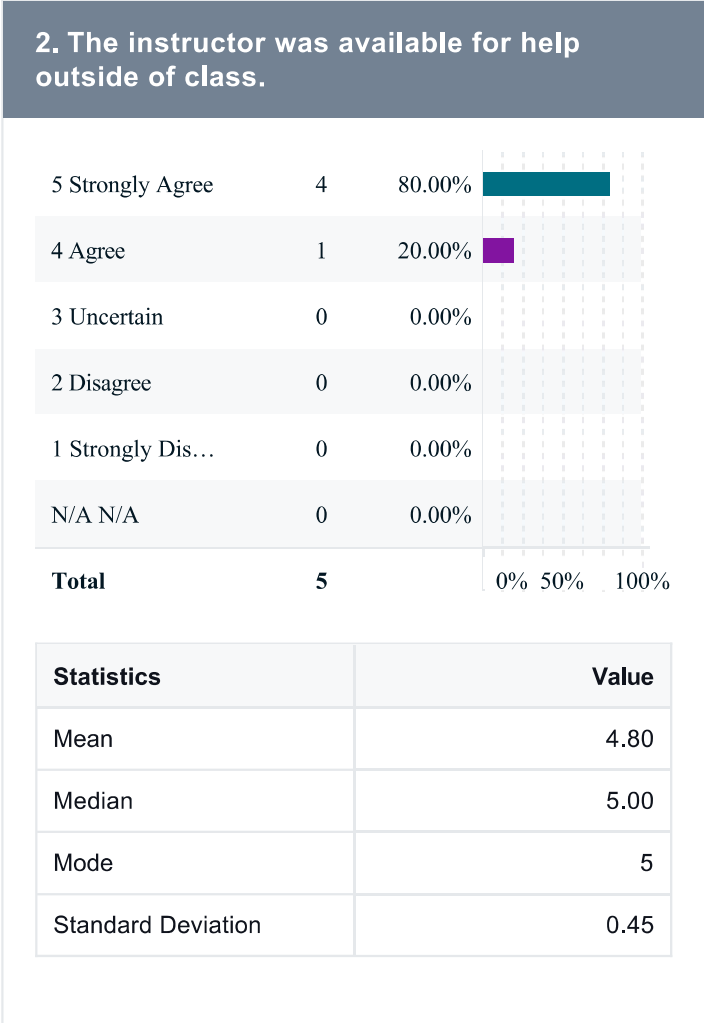
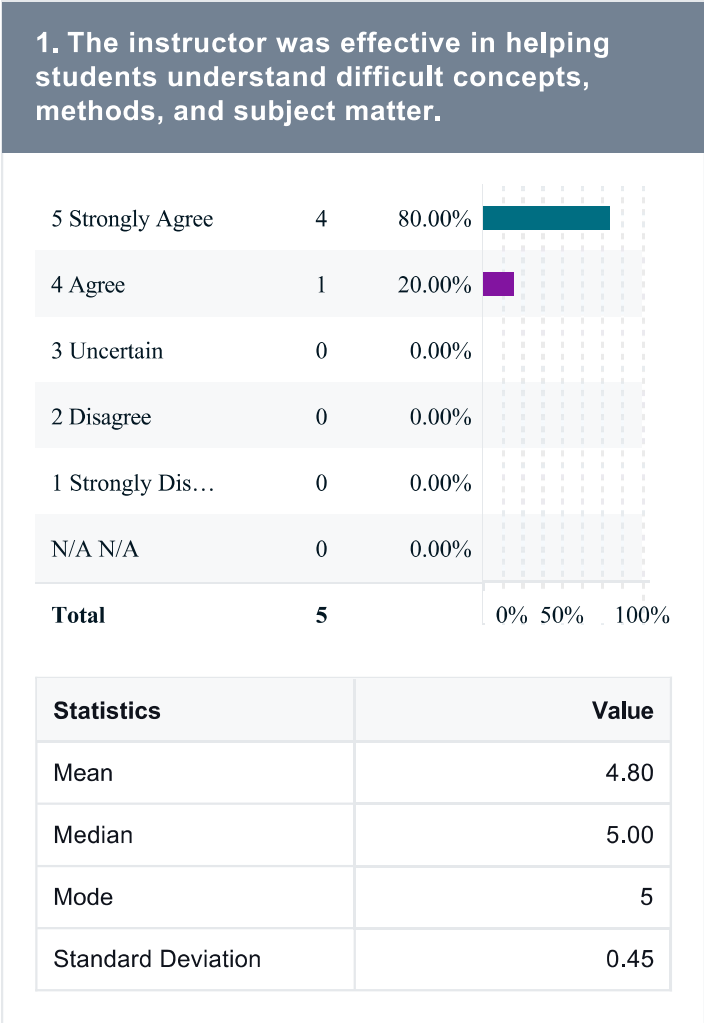

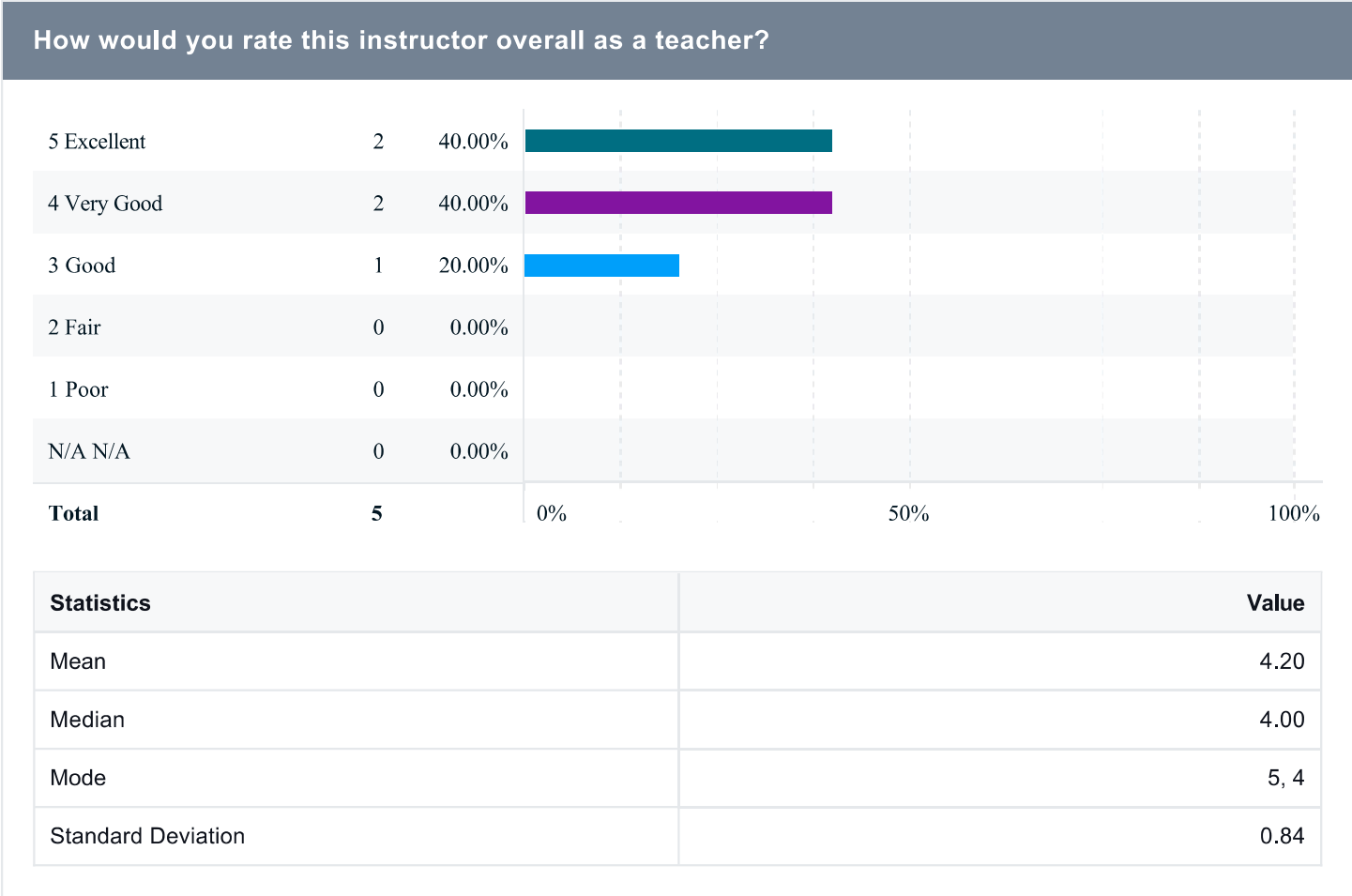
Distribution of Responses







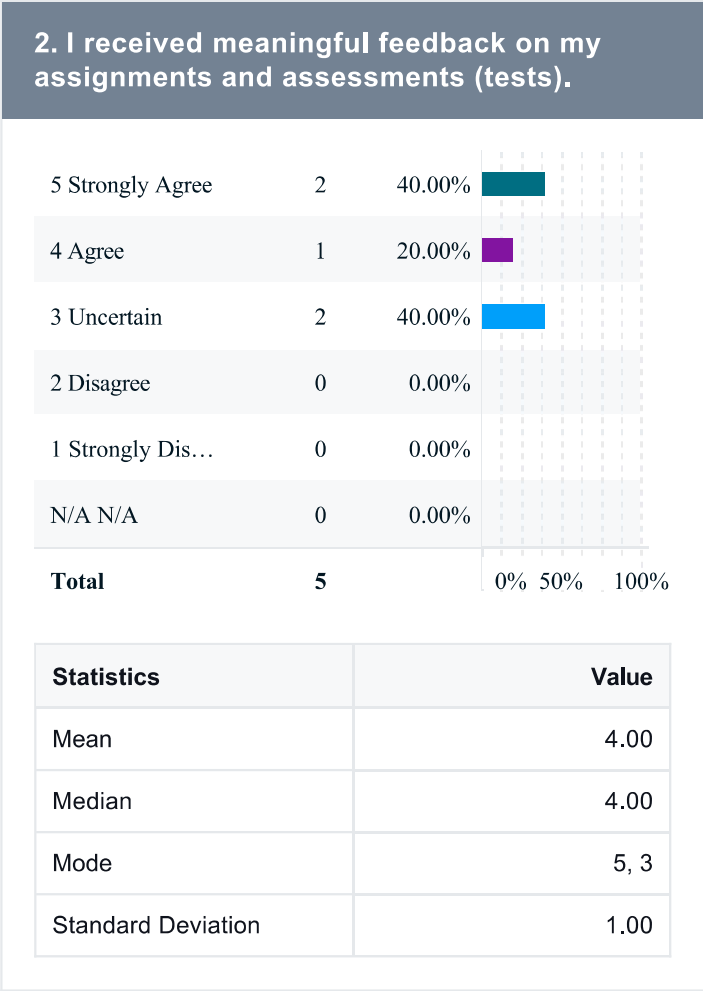
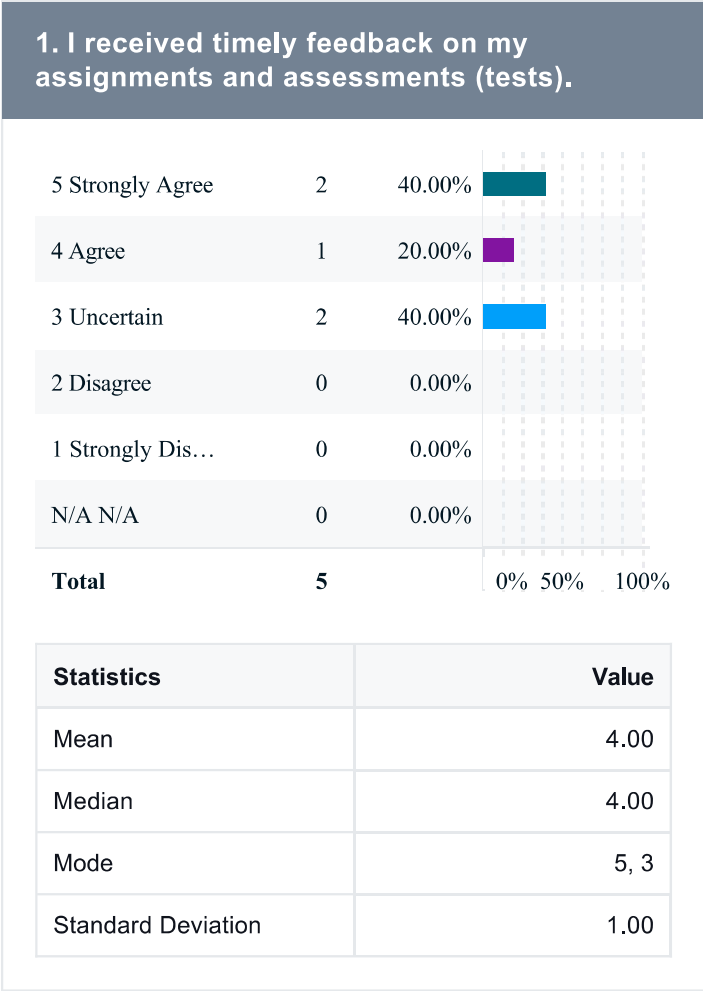

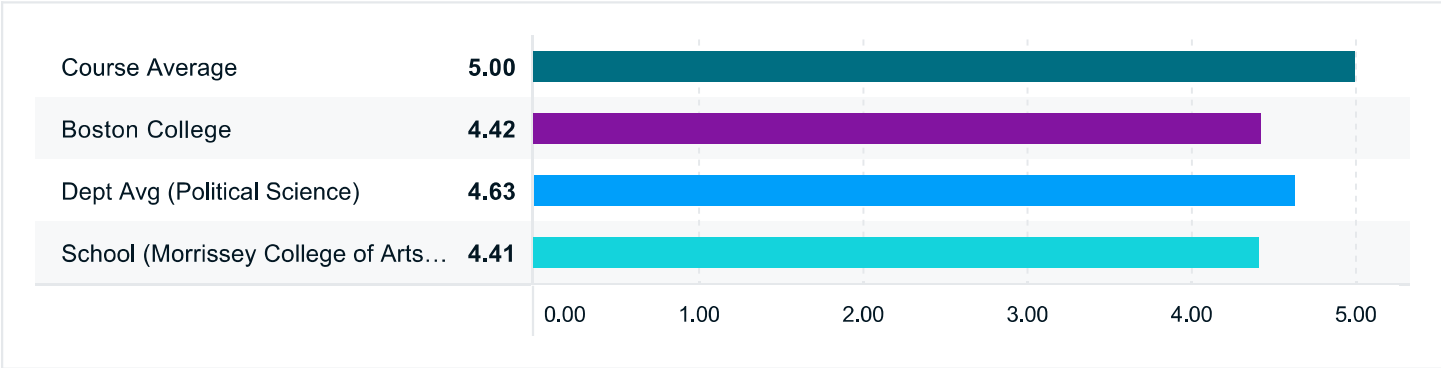
Comments

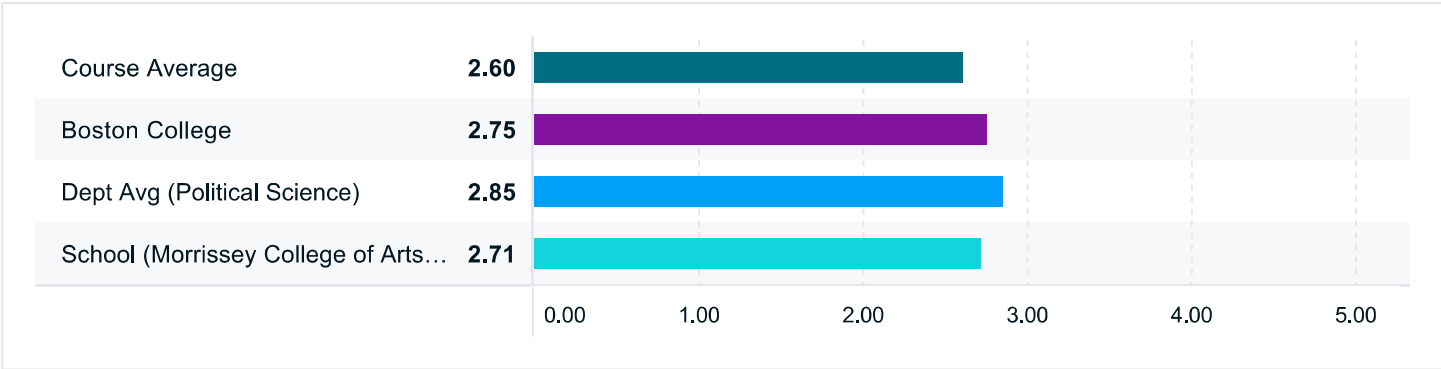

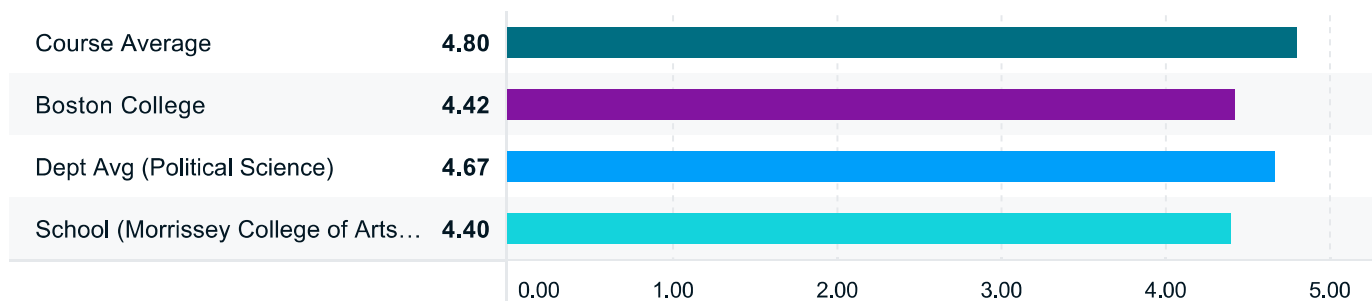


On average, how many hours per week outside of class do you devote for this course?

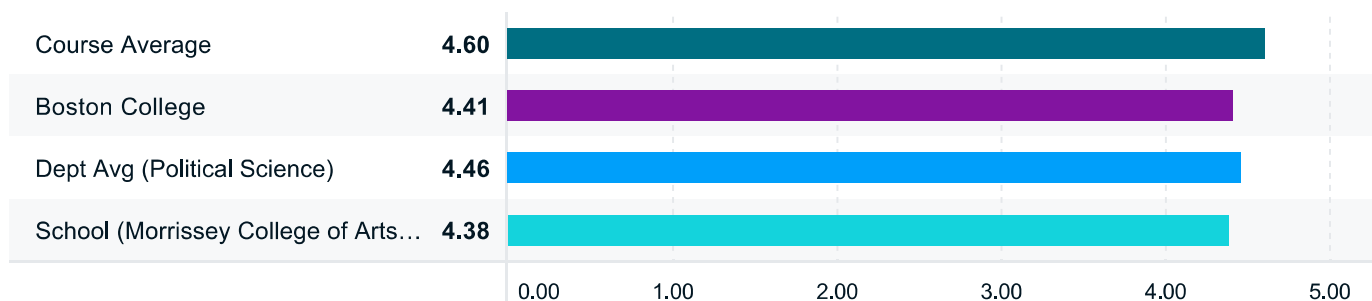
